### ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

#### **AGE:**

Birth to 21 years of age. Some services will be extended until age 22 if services were commenced or approved before 21st birthday.

#### **RESIDENCY:**

Family must be residents of State.

#### **MEDICAL ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:**

##### ***Eligible Conditions:***

Children with special health care needs are those children who have or are at risk for chronic physical, developmental, behavioral, or emotional conditions and who require health and related services of a type or amount beyond that generally required by children.

***Excluded Conditions:***

None. Contact the Program directly.

***FINANCIAL ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:***

***General Financial Eligibility: \****

Income at or below 175% of federal poverty level. A family's liquid maximum reserve cannot exceed \$2,000 with an additional \$100 allowed for each additional family member. Application must be made at the local DHS office. Forms used are the same forms used to determine financial eligibility for Title XIX.

\* Exception: No income or resource test for provision of PKU formula or screening clinics.
